The Narthex of the Sanctuary is also a good place to nurse. It not only has chairs and benches, but the viewing windows and the speaker system enable you to continue to participate in the service.

Downstairs off the Social Hall, you will find the Nursery with a rocking chair and changing table. It is staffed by qualified childcare personnel.

If your baby is easily distracted there are several quiet places where you can sit. There is a small Sitting Room right outside the side entrance of the Sanctuary. There are also comfortable chairs in the Social Hall. On occasion, the Parlor and/or the High School Room might be available.
